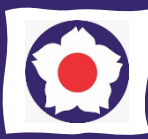

Present Perfect

é um tempo verbal que **expressa ações influenciadas pelo presente**, que ainda estão acontecendo ou foram concluídas recentemente.

already yet ever never just recently

I have **never** taken a long distance bus.



Present Perfect

Have you ever **taken** a long distance bus?

have/has + verbo na terceira forma

No, I **have** never **taken** a long distance bus.

infinitivo: forma base – quase sempre igual a forma do presente

(to) work | I work - trabalhar, eu trabalho

segunda coluna: simple past – nos verbos regulares, coloca-se um „-ed“ no final do infinitivo

I worked - eu trabalhei

terceira coluna: participio – nos verbos regulares é igual a segunda coluna

I have worked - „trabalhado“

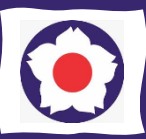
